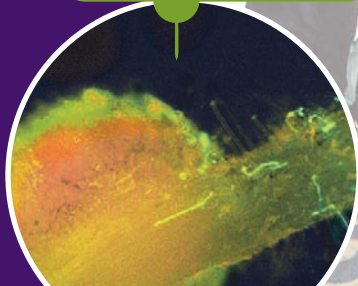
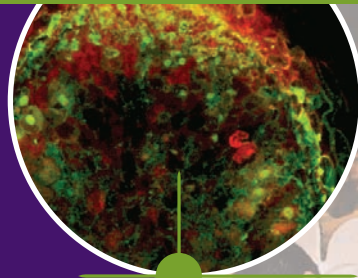

IS-MPMI brings colleagues together through the sharing of research and new ideas. IS-MPMI's journal, *Molecular Plant-Microbe Interactions (MPMI)*, publishes significant primary research and reviews on the molecular biology and genetics of pathological, symbiotic and associative interactions between microbes and plants. IS-MPMI members receive an 80% discount on subscriptions to *MPMI*.

New online features include the ability to receive notifications when papers of interest are published; ability to link citations directly to the paper cited and other citation management tools; direct links from Library Search Databases; RSS feeds; and the ability to sign up for Table-of-Content Alerts. All volumes of *MPMI* are available online and complete articles, 24 months or older, are freely accessible.
